Welcome back, we hope you all had a good half term break. Our theme for this half term is **Space**, **Aliens and Astronauts!**

We will begin by talking about fireworks, the sounds and colours they make, as well as simple rules for safety. The children will create their own firework paintings.

We will continue to have a book of the week, encouraging the children to join in with repeated phrases. We will be reading the following stories:

- Aliens love underpants.
- Whatever next.
- The Way back home.
- Aliens love Panta Claus
- Father Christmas Needs a Wee

Activities for this half term include:

- Designing underpants, creating repeating patterns
- Role play Alien café counting pennies to buy items, writing orders
- Building rockets
- Naming 2d shapes, building with shapes, shape pictures

We will also be going on the following outings this half term:

- Welly walks to look for signs of Autumn
- Visiting North Baddesley library to choose books for Pre-school.
- Nativity Performance at North Baddesley Infant School (date to be confirmed).

We will also be focusing on self-care skills and encouraging independence. Please support this by helping your child to practice taking their coat off and putting it on by themselves. If your child brings a hat, scarf and gloves to Pre-school please put them in their book bag before coming in to make it easier for them to put their belongings away.
